Towards this end, we shall be aiding Welfare of Stray Dogs with a fleet of four ambulances. Another overlooked community is the elderly, for whom we propose to create daycare centers in villages. Other initiatives include 100 free pediatric heart surgeries, and a first-of-its-kind Rotary Homeopathy Clinic at Cotton Green. Towards improved education, we shall incorporate E-learning under the Bhavishya Yaan project in five Municipal schools. Ongoing projects

Entrusted with the leadership of the newly carved District 3141, he is

And confident of 3141 reaching similar status. He intends for the year ahead to be a breakthrough year in Rotary's battle against Polio.
